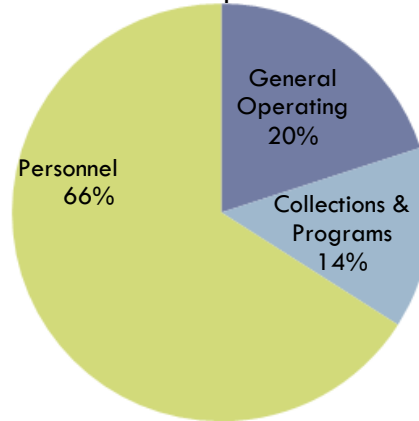

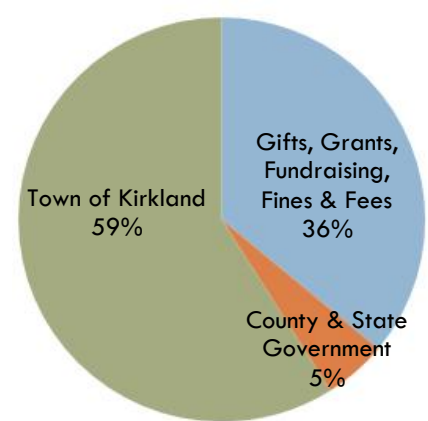

2017 Expenses



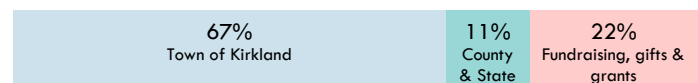
2017 Income



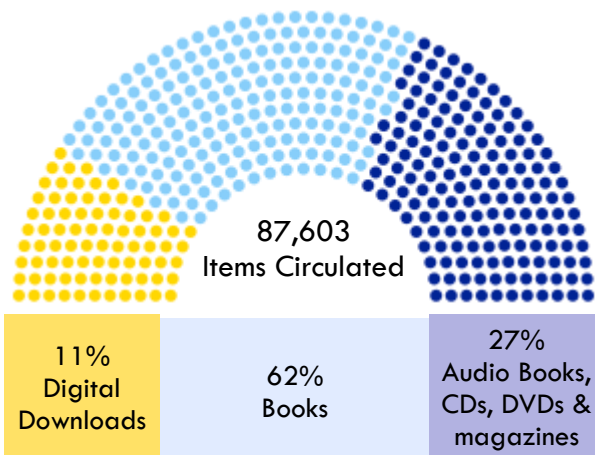
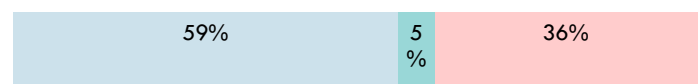
Library Financial Challenges

- The New York State minimum wage scheduled increases will raise our personnel costs 30% by 2021
