

Challenge Four: Historic Clinton Homes, 1.25 miles

Start at the Library and turn right onto College Street headed towards the Village Green. Turn left onto West Park Row. The Alexander Hamilton Institute was once the home of Othniel S. Williams, a Hamilton College Graduate and the first supervisor of the Town of Kirkland. Around the corner on Kirkland Avenue, at the site of NBT Bank, was the home of Dr. Seth and Eustice Hastings and their 15 children. (Imagine if they were all quarantined together...) Take a right onto North Park Row and continue on to Utica Street. The childhood home of President Grover Cleveland is #26. Take a right onto Mulberry Street and then a right onto Kellogg Street. Follow Kellogg back to the Village Green and continue up College Street towards the library. The house left of Subway is the home of Ozias Marvin, a Revolutionary War veteran and the namesake of Marvin St.
